








Vinay Karthik spent 11 days in November in Baku, Azerbaijan participating in the UN's 29th Climate Change Conference as a Media Logistics Manager!

December Legislation



Here's a quick glance at what CCLers across the country lobbied for this month!

Energy Permitting Reform Act of 2024

- Expands energy transmission
- Allows clean energy projects to happen faster
- Would cut American climate emissions by 10-25%

Inflation Reduction Act

- Benefits both climate and business
- Brings jobs back to America through expanding clean energy

The IRA was passed in 2022, but since the next administration may try to repeal it, CCL lobbied to protect it.

RISEE Act

- Would help develop offshore wind
- Would direct money to coastal resiliency and infrastructure

JUNE LOBBY DAYS RESULTS

 <u>Prove it Act</u>
was introduced in the House, now has 45 cosponsors
<u>ADVANCE Act</u>

passed and became law
<u>Increased TSP Access Act</u>

gained 6 cosponsors
<u>Seedlings for Sustainable Habitat</u>

gained 7 cosponsors



Nearly 1,000 citizens participated in 442 meetings on Capitol Hill!

DECEMBER LOBBY DAYS **RESULTS**



There was broad bipartisan agreement on the importance of the Energy Permitting Reform Act, and it was almost included in the final spending package. Time ran out before lawmakers could reach an agreement, but CCL will continue pushing for this legislation in the next Congress.

Climate Conversation Tips

Like many of us, at this time of year you might find yourself back at home, socializing with family members. But what do you do when <u>the</u> <u>issue of climate change comes up?</u>



We all have strong opinions! But to keep the conversation <u>helpful and friendly</u>, make sure to <u>listen</u> <u>respectfully</u> and try to bring up trusted local sources.

Prioritize respect -- this is <u>a discussion</u>, <u>not a debate!</u> It's important to hear out both sides.





Here's what our youth activists had to say about 2024!

<u>Amukta Panchangam:</u> This year, I presented to the Katy ISD School Board for the Great School Electrification Program and gained valuable insights at the 3rd Coast Regional Conference in Galveston. It was a rewarding year of growth and impact!

<u>Nadia Shutov:</u> The June conference and lobby day was an amazing opportunity to meet in person with other youth activists that I had been working for years with on Zoom.
