

Activities included student workshops, a student mixer + pizza dinner, and going to the National Mall to speak to the public about climate advocacy.






## STUDENT SUMMIT AND CONFERENCE STORIES!



# STUDENT SUMMIT AND CONFERENCE PICTURES!





On June 11th, members of CCL lobbied with Congress to build support for the PROVE IT Act. On July 9th, the Act passed in the Senate with bipartisan support and moved on to the House!

#### -What It Does-



Requires the Department of Energy to compare the **carbon emissions of products** that are produced in the United States vs. other countries.





Organizes that info to help us negotiate effectively with trading partners who have **carbon border adjustment mechanisms** (CBAMs) in place.

\*\*CBAM\*\*

A CBAM puts an extra charge on carbon-heavy goods produced outside the country.



To avoid CBAM fees, countries will lower their carbon output, thereby reducing emissions globally
